The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation exists. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 21st January 1975
Date of Commencement: 20th December 2006
Date of Termination: 19th June 2009

Weekly Wages: €800.00

This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment, which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 succeeds and the appellant is awarded €1600.00 being two weeks wages.

The claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 succeeds and the appellant is awarded €800.00.
