The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant's employment ended with the respondent by way of redundancy. It is noted that the respondent had not contested this appeal. However, the company has stated it does not have the resources to discharge a monetary amount to the appellant as a result of her redundancy.

The appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under the above Acts based on the following:
