Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative appeared on their behalf.

The appellant's gross weekly wage averaged at €471.00. The Tribunal is satisfied that, by writing to the appellant on 3 April 2009 the respondent clearly put the appellant on lay off as of 10 April 2009 for a period in excess of four weeks. The Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation existed in the company.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 31st March 1976
Date of Commencement: 18th October 2004
Date of Termination: 10th June 2009

Gross Weekly Wage: €471.00
