The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The appellant commenced employment on 12 December 2003 with the respondent He was banned from driving and received twelve penalty points. The respondent had to let the appellant go. The appellant's position was not replaced and the work that the respondent undertook was redistributed amongst the other employees.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant was made redundant and he is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth 18 January 1963
Date employment began 12 December 2003
Date employment ended 1 September 2009

Gross weekly pay €637.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment during the relevant period under the Social Welfare Acts.

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of $\[\epsilon 600.00 \]$ on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
