The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Based on the uncontested evidence of the both appellants the Tribunal finds that both are entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date employment ceased	18 December 2008
Gross weekly pay	€ 380.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal awards the sum of € 760.00 (this being two weeks gross wages) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also awards the sum of € 380.00 (this being five days annual leave) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

Second Named Appellant:

Date employment commenced	28 September 2006
Date employment ceased	18 December 2008
Gross weekly pay	€ 500.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal awards the sum of € 1,000.00 (this being two weeks gross wages) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also awards the sum of € 500.00 (this being five days annual leave) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
