The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant gave sworn testimony and his representative furnished documents relating to an employment which, after a lay-off on 16 January 2009, ended by way of redundancy with a P45 which stated 31 May 2009 to have been the date of cessation. The employment had commenced on 13 January 2005. The representative submitted that the appellant was entitled to a registered employment agreement pay rate. The Tribunal was shown a copy of revenue documentation relating to the appellant's employment.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Having heard sworn testimony and submissions and having reviewed all documentation furnished, the Tribunal makes a finding under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:27 April 1970Date of commencement:13 January 2005Date of termination:31 May 2009Gross weekly pay:€750.81

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
