The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Having heard the brief evidence from the appellant and noting the respondent's comments that he accepted there was a redundancy situation in this case the Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment with the respondent was terminated by way of redundancy. The appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:
