#### **Determination:**

It is common case that a redundancy situation exists. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	16 June 1980
Date of Commencement:	17 August 2002
Date of Termination:	14 August 2008
Gross Weekly Wage:	€680.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
