## **Determination:**

An issue arose as to whether the appellant was excluded from the Act on the grounds that his employment ended 1 month after his apprenticeship. The Tribunal is satisfied that while he was given notice of dismissal during that one month period, that notice did not expire until after the 1 month had elapsed and therefore he is not excluded.

Based on the evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal find he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:29 November 1984Date of Commencement:23 August 2004Date of Termination:15 April 2009Gross Pay:€ 459.81

Please note that this award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
