The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment as a worker with the respondent commenced on 15 February 2005 and ceased after he was let go without notice on Friday 8 August 2008 due to a downturn in construction. He sought a redundancy award

No evidence was offered at the hearing by or on behalf of the respondent to contest the appellant's case. The Tribunal had no opportunity to ask questions of the respondent at the hearing scheduled to hear both sides.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 27 July 1961
Date of commencement: 15 February 2005
Date of termination: 08 August 2008
Gross weekly pay: €597.91

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
