The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

Based on the uncontested sworn evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth	3 rd April 1951
Employment commenced	1 st November 1997
Employment ended	3 rd June 2009
Gross weekly pay	€550.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant €3300.00 being the equivalent of six weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 – 2005.
