Determination:

Although the respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed in the company he stated that he is unable to pay the appellant his redundancy payment.

Based on the appellant's uncontroverted evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
