The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination

It was common case that the respondent has ceased trading. The Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation exists and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth	22 August 1938
Date Employment Began	1 May 2004
Date Employment Ended	1 August 2008
Gross Weekly Pay	€875.77

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.
