The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal were satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 23rd March 1964 1st May 1993 15th May 2009 €628.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week.

The Tribunal award the appellant €4396.00 being the equivalent of seven weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 – 2005. Further they award €700.00 to the appellant in lieu of holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
