The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 14 September 1998, ended by reason of redundancy on 16 January 2009. His gross weekly pay was €635.00.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	17 April 1952
Date of commencement:	14 September 1998
Date of termination:	16 January 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€635.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
