Determination:

At the outset the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 was withdrawn.

The Tribunal, being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
