The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award on the grounds that his employment with the respondent company which had commenced on 2 October 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 13 February 2009. His appeal form contended that his gross weekly pay had been €546.39.

The respondent company did not contest the case.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:20 May 1972Date of commencement:02 October 2006Date of termination:13 February 2009Gross weekly pay:€546.39

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of $\notin 600.00$ per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
