This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Under the Minimum notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €1,800.00, this being two weeks gross pay as compensation in lieu of notice.
