The appellant outlined to the Tribunal that his employment terminated by reason of redundancy. The respondent company had completed the RP50 form.

#### **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Based on his uncontested evidence the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	22 <sup>nd</sup> October 1940
Date of Commencement:	23 <sup>rd</sup> May 2005
Date of Termination:	26 <sup>th</sup> February 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€636.58

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
