Determination:

The Tribunal notes that a Form T2 had been submitted on behalf of the respondent stating that the claim was not being disputed together with a covering letter indicating that redundancy had not been paid due to mere inadvertence on behalf of the respondent. Having heard the evidence of both parties the Tribunal is satisfied that the employment ended by way of redundancy and the Tribunal therefore awards to the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, calculated on the basis of the following agreed facts: -

Date of Commencement:	8 th December 2006
Date of Termination:	2 nd January 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€443.45
