The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the former employer nor a representative on his behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having heard the uncontested evidence from the appellant the Tribunal finds that his employment was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and he is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:

Date of Birth: 19 January 1955
Date of Commencement: 3 January 2004
Date of Termination: 31 July 2009
Gross Weekly Wage: €670.00

A weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to statutory redundancy payments.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 falls for want of prosecution.
