Determination:

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	3 rd February 1985
Date of Commencement:	22 nd September 2005
Date of Termination:	8 th April 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€425.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
