### The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

At the outset of the hearing the claims under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 were withdrawn.

The appellant worked as a plumber. On the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2009 he was informed there was no further work. The following day the appellant was provided with letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> March 2009 from the respondent. The letter stated that as and from that date the respondent no longer had employment to offer the appellant.
