The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal were satisfied that the respondents were properly notified of this hearing. Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 15th April 1960 1st June 1989 27th May 2009 €593.25

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal were unable to deal with minimum notice under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997; accordingly the appeal under this Act is dismissed.
