The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

A director of the respondent company gave evidence that the appellant's employment was terminated due to lack of work. He agreed that the appellant's dates and pay were as stated on the T1A form. The appellant confirmed his pay and dates of employment.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 15th February 1978
Date of Commencement: 15th March 2004
Date of Termination: 2nd January 2009
Weekly Gross Pay: €480.00
