Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the recommendation of the Rights Commissioner made under Section 7 of the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 has not been carried out by the employer in accordance with its terms or at all and it is further satisfied that the prescribed six-week time limit for bringing an appeal against the recommendation has expired and no such appeal has been brought.

Accordingly, the Tribunal orders that the Rights Commissioner's recommendation to make an award of €11,500.00 to the claimant under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 be implemented on receipt of this determination.
