Preliminary Point

The claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn by the appellant at the commencement of the hearing.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant did not receive the requisite notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005. Accordingly the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €680 being the equivalent of four weeks pay under the said Act.
