The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 - 2005 was withdrawn at the commencement of the hearing.

Determination

Having heard submissions from both parties the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was laid off through reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
