The respondent having conceded liability in this regard the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth	31 January 1950
Employment commenced	17 May 2004
Employment ended	24 May 2009
Gross weekly pay	€666-00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week
