The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 1 January 2001, ended by reason of redundancy after he was laid off on 26 December 2008. His gross weekly pay was €681.67.

No oral evidence was offered by the respondent at the hearing.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 01 July 1982
Date of commencement: 01 January 2001
Date of termination: 26 December 2008
Gross weekly pay: €681.67

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
