The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award on the grounds that he had been employed from 6 July 2004 to 14 May 2009 when his employment ended due to redundancy. His gross weekly pay was $\notin 673.00$.

No evidence was offered to the Tribunal by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal makes a finding, under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	16 July 1970
Date of commencement:	06 July 2004
Date of termination:	14 May 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€673.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of $\notin 600.00$ per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
