## **Determination:**

At the outset the claim under the Minimum Notice Acts was withdrawn and the claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 not proceeded with. The respondent having conceded the fact of redundancy the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
