The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal heard evidence in relation to the appellants' termination date. The appellant confirmed he served a RP9 on the respondent, dated 28th August 2009. One of the purposes of a RP9 is for an employee to give hisemployer notice in writing terminating his contract of employment; therefore the date the RP9 wasserved is the termination date.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth 18th February 1983
Date employment commenced 23rd September 2002
Date employment ceased 28th August 2009

Gross weekly pay € 667.50

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\[\in 600.00 \]$ per week.
