## **Determination**

The appellant worked for the respondent; an employment agency until she was made redundant on the 10<sup>th</sup> of September 2008. The appellant was placed in a company by the employment agency where she remained throughout the duration of her employment but was always paid by the employment agency.

The appellant submitted her P60's and P45 to the Tribunal. Although the 2007 P60 only shows 27 weeks worked the Tribunal are satisfied that the appellant worked continuously for the respondent. When the appellant's employment was terminated she received the full un-employment allowance from Social Welfare.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum based on the following criteria despite what the P60 indicate:
