The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The Tribunal was satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative appeared on their behalf. Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant made through an interpreter, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 14<sup>th</sup> September 1955 15<sup>th</sup> January 2007 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 €362.30

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant €724.60 being the equivalent of two weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 – 2005.
