The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on its behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that his employment with the respondent was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:

Statutory redundancy payments carry a weekly ceiling of €600.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 succeeds and the appellant is awarded €1286.22 as compensation for his outstanding notice entitlement.
