The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award on the grounds that his employment, which commenced on 13 October 2003, ended by reason of redundancy on 29 May 2009. His gross weekly pay had been €744.00.

No evidence was offered at the hearing by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 23 January 1984
Date of commencement: 13 October 2003
Date of termination: 29 May 2009
Gross weekly pay: €744.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
