The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on  $15^{\text{th}}$  May 1979 and was let go when the business closed down on  $5^{\text{th}}$  February 2009. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid  $\notin$ 425.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

## **Determination**

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
