The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

At the outset the appellant withdrew his appeal under the Minimum Notice And Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The respondent agreed that the appellant had been made redundant and was entitled to a redundancy lump sum. However he pleaded inability to pay due to financial constraints. Both parties agreed the dates and rate of pay detailed below.

## **Determination**

Having considered the evidence adduced the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date notice received	N/A
Termination date	23 <sup>rd</sup> February 2009
Gross pay	€554.04
