Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal find that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	31 st May 1977
Date of Commencement:	7 th January 1996
Date of Termination:	6 th February 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€1415.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment during the period. It should be noted that a ceiling of €600.00 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 is dismissed as it has been heard by a Rights Commissioner as part of an appeal under the Payment of Wages Act 1991.
