The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal was subjected to conflicting evidence on almost every aspect of this case. Neither the appellant nor the respondent could substantiate their version of events with independent witnesses or convincing documentary evidence. Having considered the adduced evidence and submissions the Tribunal, on balance, favours the appellant's account. The Tribunal does not accept that the appellant resigned from the respondent during his service of employment. While there were some breaks in his employment in 2009 the appellant was never formally placed in a lay-off or short-time situation. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:

Gross Weekly Wage: €600.00
