The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

## **Determination:**

On the first day of hearing the liquidator was not properly on notice and the appeal was adjourned to allow the liquidator to be put on notice. On the second day of hearing the respondent conceded the fact of redundancy. Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment of €3,623-06 under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
