The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal are satisfied that they were properly notified of the hearing.

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 16th October 2005 and was let go when the business closed down on 7th March 2009. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €497.26 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date notice received	21st February 2009
Termination date	7 th March 2009
Gross pay	€497.26
