Determination

By letter dated the 4th of October 2010 the respondent conceded that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on 11 years service and not the 4 years service she was paid by the respondent. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria, deducting the payment already received by the appellant for her final 4 years of service;

Date of Birth:	26 th September 1960
Date of Commencement:	1 st September 1997
Date of Termination:	15 th September 2008
Gross Pay:	€120.00
