**The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:**

The appellant's employment had terminated on 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2008. His appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, was lodged with the Tribunal in May 2010. The appellant was unable to show reasonable cause as to why his appeal was outside the stipulated 52-week time limit.

**Determination:**

As the appellant failed to show reasonable cause for the delay in submitting his appeal, the Tribunal finds it has no jurisdiction to extend the time limit as set out under S.24 as amended by S.12. The Tribunal dismisses the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007.
