The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came to the Tribunal as an appeal by the employer company against Rights Commissioner Recommendation r-072175-te-08/EH by which the employer was ordered to pay the employee the sum of €400.00 under the Terms of Employment Acts, 1994 and 2001.

Appellant's Case

No evidence was offered at the hearing by or on behalf of the appellant company because no-one attended the hearing to prosecute the appeal.

Respondent's Case

The respondent and his solicitor attended the hearing but the appeal was not prosecuted by the appellant company.

Determination:

The Tribunal dismisses the appeal by the employer company against Rights Commissioner Recommendation r-072175-te-08/EH by which the employer was ordered to pay the employee the sum of €400.00 under the Terms of Employment Acts, 1994 and 2001 and upholds the said Rights Commissioner Recommendation under the said legislation.
