claimed that he did not receive 10.5 days' holiday pay which was due to him.

Determination:

Allowing the claim lodged under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €427.00 (this amount being equivalent to one week's gross pay at €427.00 per week).

In addition, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of \in 896.70 (this amount being equivalent to 10.5 days' gross pay at \in 427.00 per week) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, in respect of holidays outstanding at the time of termination of his employment with the respondent.
