Determination

Having heard the uncontested evidence from the appellant the Tribunal finds that his employment was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and she is awarded a statutory lump sum based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	13 th April 1976
Date of Commencement:	6 th March 2006
Date of Termination:	7 th May 2009
Gross Weekly Wage:	€1153.85

The appellant partially received her statutory redundancy lump sum in the amount of €4,236.00; the appellant was due €4416.00. Due to a discrepancy, the respondent miscalculated the appellant's redundancy entitlement; the appellant is now due a further €180.00 to complete her redundancy payment.
