Determination:

There was no appearance or representation for the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that proper notification was sent to the respondent. The Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment with the respondent ended by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the Tribunal awards the appellant a statutory redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on his continuous service and the following information:

Date of birth: 02nd March 1964

Date employment commenced: 29th March 2005

Date employment ended: 26th December 2009

Gross weekly wage: €811.20

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. Also note that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00, applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
