The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 and under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1967 to 2007 were withdrawn.

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed and that there was no documentary proof of a break in the claimant's service. Accordingly the Tribunal awards the claimant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:
